Acrylic Painting Class - Supply List

Paints - I recommend Golden OPEN* Acrylic paints.

*Please Note: **Golden OPEN Acrylic.**

Primary Colors:

- Naphthol Red Medium *Burnt Sienna
- Aliz. Crimson *Raw Umber
- Hansa Yellow *Paynes Gray
- Cerulean Blue *Titanium White (large)
- Ultramarine Blue

We can actually mix any color from these primaries. Of course you may add any color you favor for your particular painting. I love using these:

Sap Green - mixing only
Viridian Green - mixing only
Cobalt Blue
Quinacridone Magenta
Quinacridone Nickel Azo Gold
Indian Yellow
Manganese Blue

Medium -

- Golden 'Open' Acrylic Thinner (Small)
- Golden Gel Medium – Soft Gel (Gloss)

Palette – 12” x16” Masterson air tight container with sponge and disposal paper palette sheets. With Golden OPEN, you will want to replace the sponge and paper palettes with a piece of clear glass to fit your container. If you use regular glass, be sure to wrap the edges with electrician’s tape to protect from cuts. Tempered glass palettes with beveled edges are available (a great idea). Retain your sponge for other uses.

Canvas – I recommend 24” x 36” or smaller due to space limitations. Wrapped canvases do not require framing.

*These canvas boards are suggested for color charts

Brushes – (you can use the same bristle brushes normally used in oil painting.)

- Flat: 1” & 2”
- Round: 1 small & 1 medium (choose from sizes 4-10)
- Bristle Brushes:
 - Bright (short stiff hairs hold lots of paint & make a heavily textured stroke);
 - Flat (longer bristles make a flat stroke or depending on how held, creates a linear stroke);
 - Filbert (long tapered shape will make a softer stroke)
- Liner: long sharp point is excellent for tree limbs & twigs, grasses, signing your painting, etc.

If you already have brushes, bring your favorites. ** (You will need medium & small size brushes for the canvas size.)

Palette Knife – 1

Easel – Table top or floor. There will be room for your floor easel. .

You will also need -

- Old cotton clean-up cloths (rags) and paper towels
- Two containers for water

I will not have art supplies available. The nearest art store I am aware of is **Artist’s Edge**, Hwy 305 in Poulsbo, **Artist’s Edge**, Silverdale Way in Silverdale and **Pro Art Source** in Gig Harbor. The staff and management will help you with your supply needs; plus these are great people to get to know!

Table and chairs, coffee and tea are provided.
